Network length

The network length of the roads in Andorra is 320 km.

The length of the "Túnel d'Envalira" concession (the only one in Andorra) is 4,2 kilometers and the length of the tunnel itself is 2.880 meters. Its altitude is 2.050 meters above sea level.



Investments


There are no relevant investments in 2017.

"Túnel d'Envalira" has been financed by a long-term syndicated bank loan, equity and capital grant.

In Andorra tolls are collected by credit cards or cash.

Toll rates

The toll rates in Andorra are annually recalculated as result of the following formula:

 $T_{2017} = T_{2016} x (1 + ((CPI_{ANDORRA} x 50\% + CPI_{FRANCE} x 25\% + CPI_{SPAIN} x 25\%) x 0,95))$

In 2017 the tolls haven't changed.



Safety

In 2017 there were fortunately no fatal accidents.

Forecast and tendencies

Andorra's economy traditionally has been very dependent on its neighbors France and Spain. The stability of France and the recovery of Spain suggest that Andorra will tend to improve slightly.
